This is in response to Petition No. 22 tabled in the Legislature on Friday, April 17, 2020, by Mr. Coon. This petition is requesting a year-round car ferry service to the Canadian Mainland from Campobello Island.

I understand the transportation concerns and uncertainties of Campobello Island residents. I have met with federal elected officials to express these concerns, and officials in my department are participating on a federal-provincial-territorial committee established under the Council of Ministers Responsible for Transportation and Highway Safety to discuss potential options to address marine-related transportation challenges.

The safety of our residents is the paramount concern of our government at this time, and I appreciate your leadership and cooperation in helping us contain the spread of COVID-19.
